HealthWell Foundation® assists patients living with psoriasis

Gaithersburg, MD (August 22, 2007) – In recognition of National Psoriasis Awareness Month, sponsored by the National Psoriasis Foundation, the HealthWell Foundation® would like to remind psoriasis patients and their health care providers that help is available for patients living with psoriasis who have difficulty affording their insurance copayments and other out-of-pocket costs of treatment.

Approximately 7.5 million Americans live with psoriasis, according to the National Institutes of Health. Psoriasis is a chronic disease characterized by inflammation of the skin, and in its more severe forms can have a seriously negative impact on a patient's quality of life. A small number of psoriasis patients may also get arthritis, which is distinct from Rheumatoid Arthritis and called Psoriatic Arthritis.

"HealthWell provides financial assistance to patients living with a wide range of health conditions, including psoriasis and psoriatic arthritis," said Dr. Nancy Carteron, MD, FACR, a Fellow of the American College of Rheumatology and a Vice President of the Foundation's Board of Directors. "We hope that by providing access to treatment for serious and chronic conditions, we are able to improve the quality of lives as well as save lives."
